

# Ministry Team Covenant

In order to fulfill the goals set forth for each Ministry Team trip, the following guidelines have been established for each team member:

- Each member must profess Jesus Christ as his or her personal Savior.
- Each member must provide a letter of recommendation to team leadership from his/her pastor. If necessary, an interview will be conducted to determine compatibility with the spiritual beliefs of our group.
- Active participation is expected of all team members. Team members must work together to perform any task assigned. Each team member will assist in outreach and evangelism activities.
- Behavior during ministry trip must be consistent with disciplined Christian conduct. In the interest of unity and to avoid conflict, the use of alcohol or tobacco is prohibited.
- Due to the customs and cultural beliefs of Mexico, it is necessary to establish a dress code. Team leadership will determine dress codes. Team members will be asked to change if their attire is not appropriate.
- Team members are responsible for the entire cost of each trip.
- While in Mexico, any member who may be unsure of the propriety of any action should consult with his/her leader. Some things considered acceptable in the U.S. might be misunderstood or misconstrued by citizens of Mexico.

Failure to observe these guidelines could seriously hinder the pastor or ministry from their ongoing ministries. For this reason, we ask each team member to search their hearts for God's will before committing themselves to this effort and our team.
